Since 1983, besides performing in a number of Symphonies and Chamber Orchestras, Linda has founded DaCore Talent Education Academy in Glenmore, Pennsylvania and then took a teaching position at the Hartt School of Music at the University of Hartford as Music Specialist where she taught college students at the conservatory and pre-college students at the in the community division and trained upcoming Suzuki teacher trainer. Three years ago Linda and Domenick returned to Pennsylvania to continue development of DaCore Talent Education Academy and Fiore Performing Strings. Linda has traveled all over the world, including Tanzania, Singapore, Puerto Rico Bermuda and through out the United States teaching and training teachers.
